Decorative map of the world on Mercator's projection, hand colored by countries. Major cities, rivers, islands, bays, lakes, gulfs, mountains, etc. are shown. The first hint of Antarctica is present. Includes decorative embellishments above the map and in the border. G.F. Cruchley was a mapseller and globemaker on Fleet Street in London in the mid-19th Century. His World Atlas, first published in 1854, was very unique for the period, employing vivid imagery and a striking print style, along with very distinctive coloring. Maps from his world atlas are relatively scarce on the market.
