



One of the Earliest Maps of Colima Printed In Mexico

Scarce map of Colima in Mexico, from Antonio Garcia y Cubas' monumental *Atlas Geographico, Estadistico e Historico de la Republica Mexicana*, the first atlas of the Mexican Republic.

Colima is on the Pacific coast of central Mexico, the capital and main city is also called Colima. The port city of Manzanillo is in Colima.

Antonio Garcia y Cubas was Mexico's first great map maker and his work is highly sought after. This map shows the various regions within Colima, including, towns, roads, rivers, etc. Only 300 examples of the atlas were reportedly printed and separate maps rarely appear on the market.

The map is rare on the market; this is the first time we have had it.
