The map differentiates the political subdivisions of the Kingdom of Naples with fine outlining in hand-color.

The Kingdom of Naples was a major political entity in the southern Italian peninsula from 1282 to 1808. In 1816 it was joined with Sicily to form the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies, and in 1861 it was annexed to form the Kingdom of Italy.
