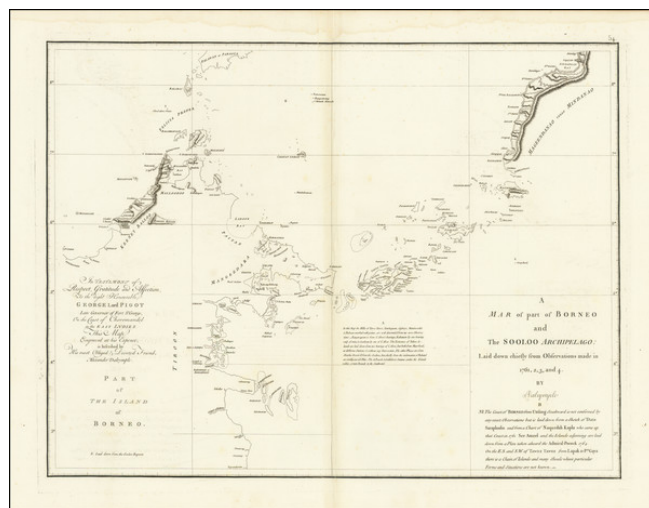

Detailed 18th-century engraved chart of the northern part of Borneo and southern part of the Philippines, including the Sulu Archipelago and the southwestern tip of Mindanao.

The map is based on the world of Alexander Dalrymple and was published by d'Après de Manneville in the 1770s.

The map includes a dedication by Dalrymple to George Lord Pigot, Late Governor of Fort St. George in India.

The map probably just reaches Bandar Seri Begawan in Brunei.

Detailed Condition:
