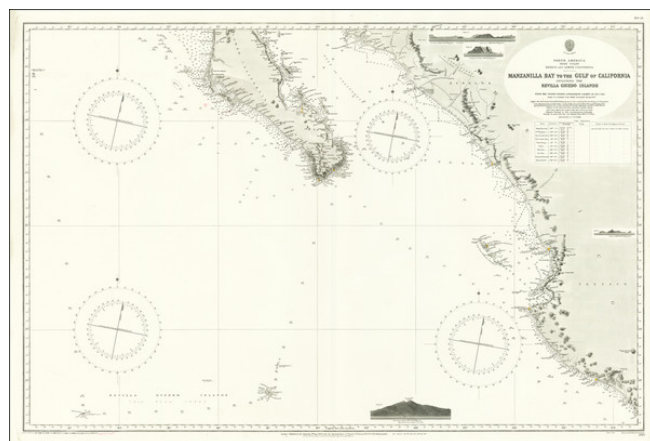

Description:

Detailed British Admiralty sea chart of part of the Pacific coast of Mexico, covering the southern end of Baja California, and the mainland coast south to just past Manzanilla.

The map was first issued in 1879, but, as with all sea charts, it was updated consistently to improve the accuracy of the information. This chart was updated by hand to 1927, with breakers off Santa Margarita Island reported from as late as 1926.

The map covers a popular sailing and tourist region, including Cabo San Lucas, La Paz, and Manzanilla.
