## **Description:**

Detailed map of Florida, hand-colored by counties, from an early edition of Johnson & Browning's *Family Atlas*.

Shows towns, railroads, villages, post offices, forts, swamps, etc. Inset of the Keys. Only five counties shown in the southern part of Florida, including Dade, Monroe, Brevard, Manatee, and Hillsboro. The map includes an early appearance of Miami.

Indian hunting grounds noted in between Ft. Poinsett and Key Biscayne Bay. Many early forts appear. The GLO surveys are not yet complete in the Everglades and elsewhere.

Decorative border. A nice Civil War map of Florida.

This is the 1861-62 edition with the Brunswick & Pensacola RR name partially erased to "Brunswick &...A".
