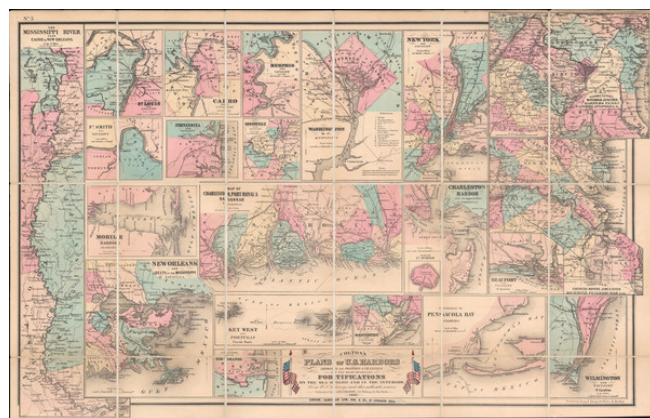

An important and scarce multi-image chart sheet, showing the harbors of the United States, and particularly those of importance during the Civil War.

The first edition of 1861 did not include the inset of the Mississippi River, which was introduced for this 1862 edition.

The map includes plans of New Orleans; Mobile; Fort Smith; St. Louis; Cairo; Fernandina; Charleston, Port Royal and Savannah; Key West; Rio Grande; Memphis; Louisville; Washington D.C.; Galveston; Charleston Harbor; New York; Washington and northern Virginia; Norfolk and the Tidewater Region; Beaufort; Pensacola; and Wilmington.
