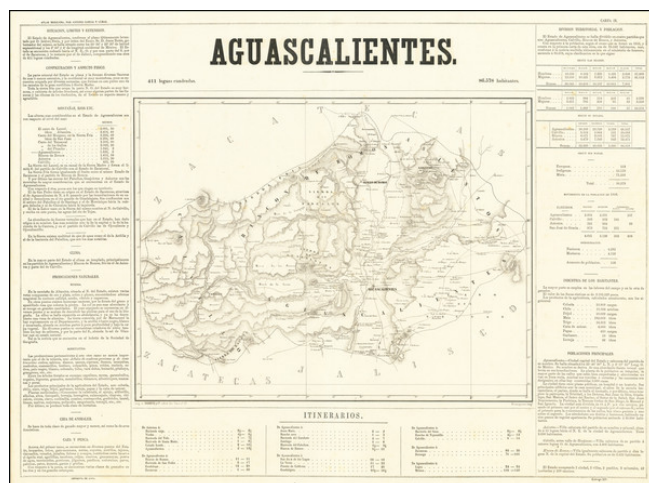

Description:

Scarce antique lithographed map of the central Mexican state of Aguascalientes, from Antonio Garcia y Cubas's monumental *Atlas Geographico, Estadistico e Historico de la Republica Mexicana*, the first atlas of the Mexican Republic.

Much like the United States maps of Carey & Lea, the Garcia y Cubas Mexican state maps include vital statistics and descriptions of the areas they depict, flanked off to the sides of the image.

Antonio Garcia y Cubas was Mexico's first great map maker and his work is highly sought after. This map shows the various regions within Aguascalientes, including, towns, roads, rivers, etc. Only 300 examples of the atlas were reportedly printed and separate maps rarely appear on the market.
