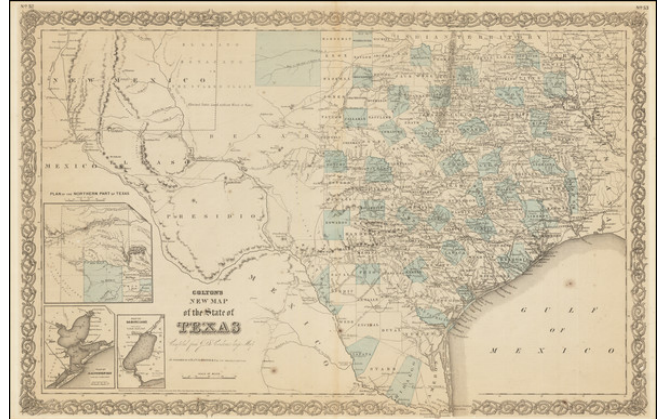

Dating The Map

We date that map based upon the configuration of Maverick County, Dimmit County, Uvalde County and Zavala County. In September 1866, these counties were resurveyed and shifted uniformly to the west, extending the width of the last 3 of these counties and splitting Maverick County in 2 parts.
