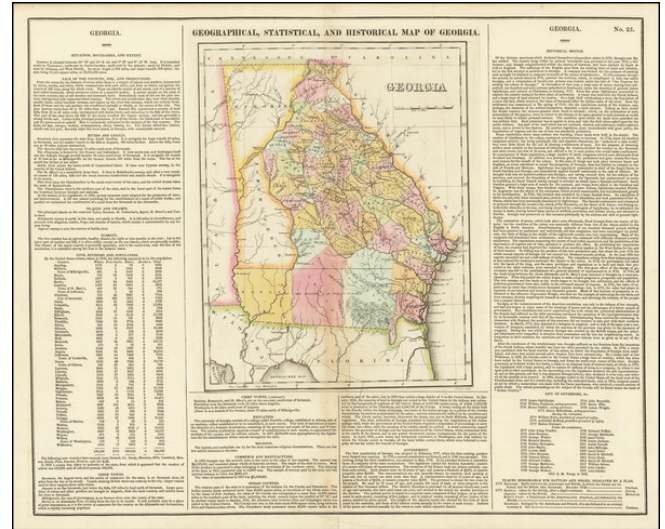

Rare Final State

Nice example of this fine map of Georgia, from the 1827 edition of Carey & Lea's *Geographical, Statistical and Historical Atlas of America*, with two columns of contemporary news accounts pasted to the back of the map.

The present map many changes, including a completely re-worked course of the Chattahoochee River and a reconfiguration of the southernmost counties in Georgia, with the northern boundaries moved slightly to the south.

Many counties still not formed. Size includes text below map, which includes wonderful contemporary details concerning the topography, indigenous lands, rivers, climate, towns, manufacturing, commerce, education, history, population by county (divided into white, free colored, and slaves), Indian Country and other information. Large region in Northwest corner is Cherokee Lands, with Lower Creek lands below. Huge Early, Irwin and Appling Counties shown. Below are East and West Florida.
