

First Appearance of Idaho on a Printed Map

Fine early map of the Pacific Northwest, published shortly after the creation of Idaho Territory in 1863.

Shows the early evolution of Western Territorial Borders. In this map, Idaho includes all of what would become Montana and Wyoming.

Shows early counties, roads, Indian tribes, forts, etc. Immediately prior to exploration of Yellowstone Park.

The map was first issued in 1863. This seems to be an 1864 edition, with an updated border. This state may not be referenced in Ira Lourie's Johnson Project compilation.
