

Description:

Interesting World War II-era map of the world, illustrating a number of key geopolitical and military concepts that would have been of interest to an avid news follower in 1941.

Ominously, the effective range of the Japanese fleet is shown to be thousands of miles short of Midway and Hawaii, which of course, would be attacked by Japan later that year.

The world map is spread across two images, printed front and back, one focusing on the Americas, East Asia, and the Pacific, the other showing Europe, Africa, and western Asia.

The map differentiates between Axis Powers, Axis-occupied territory, places defeated by the Axis but not occupied, and places occupied by Britain and her Allies. At that time, the U.S. was non-belligerent and is colored as such.

The map was made for Don Lee Broadcasting System "The Nation's Greatest Regional Network."
