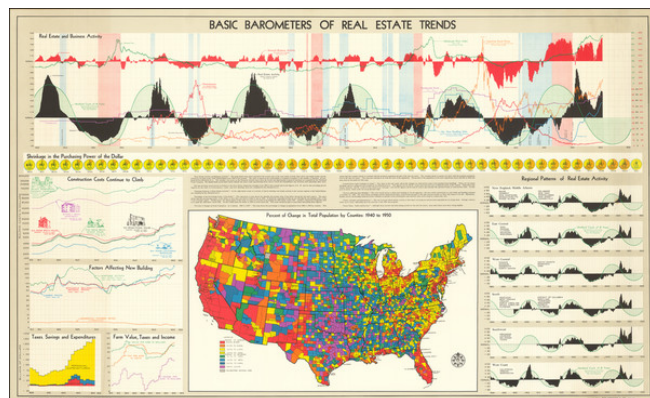

Rare data visualization map focusing on real estate trends throughout American history, published by Roy Wenzlick & Company.

The map illustrates real estate trends in the United States between 1940 and 1950, using a map and series of graphs and diagrams, including a series of coins representing the Shrinkage of the Purchasing Power of the US Dollar between 1900 and 1950.

The chart looks at different regional activities, different tax and monetary metrics, and business cycle correlations.

Wenzlick rose to fame by predicting the boom in real estate values in the 1940s, the period covered by this graphic. Wenzlick was an avid antique map collector.
