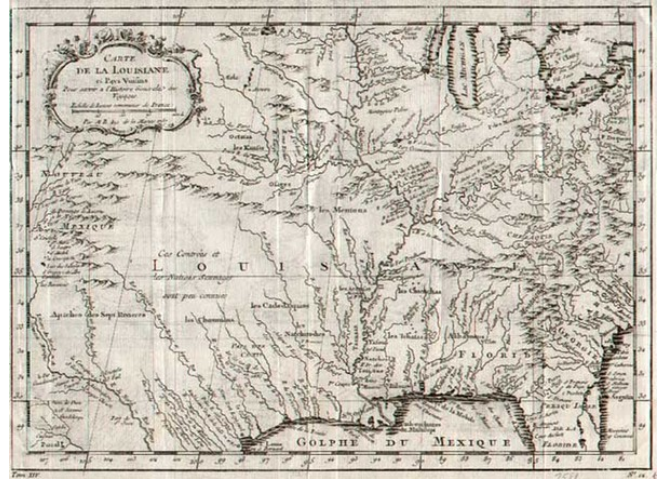

Description:

Fabulous map of the Central United States, after De L'Isle's monumental map, centered on the Mississippi River. The map provides marvelous detail in the interior of the US on either side of the Mississippi, including the early French Forts. The exploration & settlement west of the Mississippi is also shown, including Forts, Indian Villages and other placenames. In the west, many Indian names are shown. The map highlights the unknown region in Northern Texas & Indian Territory, between the Mississippi and Rio Grande. The first settlements west of New Orleans along the Gulf Coast and the interior of Texas are shown, along with the courses of a number of rivers, which end in the Nation of Savages. A very strong fresh engraving.
