Nice example of the Anna Seile's map of America, first published in 1652.

The map has been re-engraved by Robert Vaughan at the direction of Seile's widow Anae, making it the earliest map to show California as an Island published by a woman.

The map is very similar to the earlier map by Henry, although the nomenclature of the Delaware River, Carolina and several places on the west coast have been changes.
