A magnificent hand-colored engraved celestial plate from "the most elaborate atlas of stars and constellations published to date and perhaps the last great star atlas." - David Rumsey

Impressive celestial engraving from the large folio 1801 first edition of Johann Elert Bode's *Uranographia*. The plate depicts the constellations of Draco, Cauda Draconis, Ursa Minor, Camelopardalus, Rangifer, Messium, and Cepheus.

The image has a particularly striking treatment of the circumpolar constellation Draco, which was one of the first 48 constellations of Ptolemy in the 2nd century. Draco, or the dragon, is magnificently shown as a serpent with a bearded head. Other primary depictions are just as impressive, but notable also are the faintly engraved constellations that form the background of the image.
