Loma, False Bay, Bahia de los Temblores (Earthquake Bay), San Pasqual, Cariso Creek, Agua Caliente, Warner's Pass, The Colorado Desert prior to the formation of the Salton Sea, San Luis Rey, San Juan Capistrano, San Pedro and Bay, Santa Margarita River, San Luis River, San Bernardino, Bernardino Mountain, San Gabriel, Los Angeles and other place names. The map is colored to show the geological details of the region. A similar map was issued by the US Coast Survey. An essential map for early California collectors.
