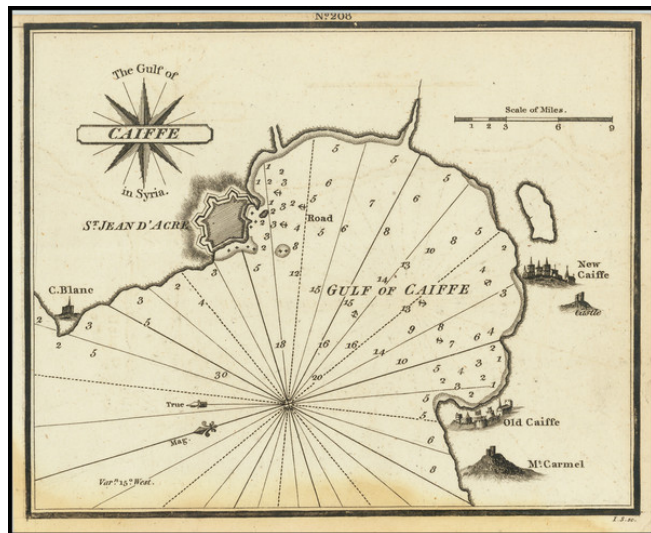

Description:

Rare antique engraved chart of the Gulf of Haifa, published by William Heather in London.

The chart is oriented with east at the top and shows the area between Acre and Haifa, including Mount Carmel.

The chart includes soundings, some topographical features and anchorages. The Old Castle and New Castle of Haifa are shown, as are the fortification of St. Jean d'Acre, an important port which saw sieges and other action during the crusades.

Rarity

The charts from Heather's *New Mediterranean Pilot* . . . are extremely rare on the market. This is the first example of the chart we have ever seen.
