

Decorative antique engraved map of the world on Mercator's Projection, by Emanuel Bowen.

Shows the magnetic variations of the compass, based upon the rare and important Edmond Halley map of the world, first published in 1702 by Mount & Page.

The Northwest Coast of North America is still labeled "Parts Undiscovered". Only about half of the Australian coastline is shown and only a small part of New Zealand's coastline, only 30 years before Cook. No sign of Antarctica.

Mentions the "Sea of Korea".
