The Course of The Nile To Its Mythical Sources

Fine old color example of this finely engraved map of Nubia, Abbysinia and surrounding regions, first published by Nicholas Sanson in 1657.

The map shows the course of the Nile River, originating in Zaire or Zebre Lake and Zaflant Lake, to Assuan (Aswan) in southern Egypt.

Sanson was the Royal Geographer to the King of France and perhaps the most important commercial mapmaker of his generation.
