

Description:

Attractive vintage map of Mount Rainier National Park, published for the Chicago Milwaukee St. Paul and Pacific Railroad. The map shows the extent of the National Park, including the various trails, roads, and campsites of the area. The numerous glaciers climbing up the mountain can be seen. A path makes its way up to Columbia Crest via McClure Rock and Camp Muir.

The work also includes numerous advertisements for various side trips which customers of the railroad can take. The verso includes a train map of the western United States and further advertises the comforts and advantages of the trip.

Numerous snippets of interesting information are provided regarding how early travelers would have visited the park. The various campsites and hotels are described in detail. The cost for a summit climb (with guide) is provided at a base of \$62.00, with add-ons available.
