

Nice example of Mathew Carey's map of Pennsylvania, one of the best large format maps of the state to appear in a commercial atlas.

The map is attractively hand-colored by counties, showing towns, roads, mountains, rivers, lakes, and a host of other early important details.

This first appeared in Carey's *General Atlas*, which was published in 1814. This was the first American Atlas to be offered for sale with hand coloring on the maps.
