Decorative example of Homann's earliest map of Spain, Portugal and the Balearic Islands, with decorative large cartouche, and elaborate naval scene.

Of the three general maps of Spain engraved by Johann Baptiste Homann, this is perhaps the most decorative, with a marvelous allegorical scene showing the Spanish Armada at Sea, the success of Spain's conquests around the world in the form of trade and two ornate coats of arms, held aloft by a cherub. A nice dark impression, pre-dating the issuance of a privilege to Homann.

Detailed Condition:
