The map is centered on the area around on Turin and extends from Antibes on the French coast to Savona.

Nicolas Sanson's 'Les Cartes Generales' was first published in 1658. This map was introduced in 1665, this example is a later state with the imprint changed.

Sanson was France's premier cartographer and helped to lift French work in this area to another level. His atlas is the first full world atlas to be produced in France.
