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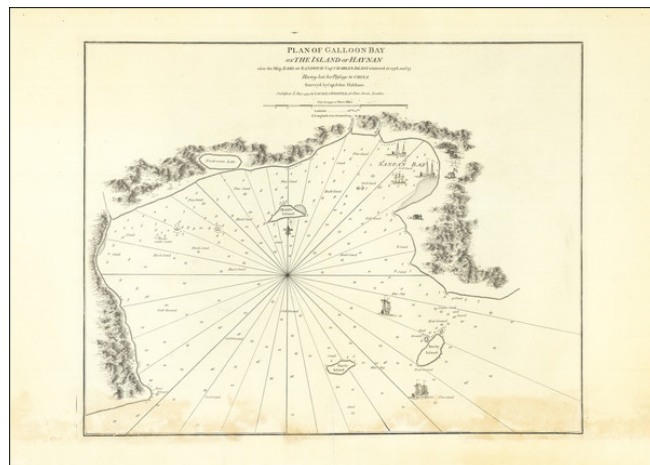
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**[Hainan] Plan of Galloon Bay on the Island of Hay-Nan where the Ship Earl of Sandwich

Rare large format chart Sanya Bay and environs, on of the southern coast of Hainan, from Laurie & Whittle's *East-India Pilot, or Oriental Navigator* . . .

This chart is drawn from the work of Captain John Haldane, who conducted a survey of the region for the British East India Company between 1776 and 1777. .

Haldane surveyed the region in 1776-77, during a stopover aboard the *Sandwich*, while waiting for wind conditions to improve to complete a voyage to Canton.
