

Highly detailed map, extending from the Great Desert of Selima and Kuku to Donga and the Dominons of a princes called Ibbe, Caffa (a Christian State), Bali and the Gulf of Aden.

Nice detail along the Red Sea and the Upper Nile, its sources and the Cataracts, etc. Highly detailed regional map, one of the best regional maps of the area to appear in an English Atlas during the period. Pinkerton's now rare elephant folio atlas is one of the best engraved works of the period. While lesser known than the more common atlases by Cary & Thomson, it is a superior work, especially in the detail of the maps.
