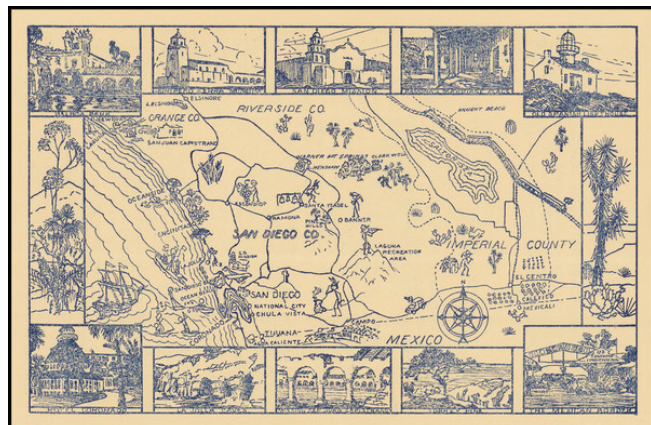

It continues on to describe the weather, zoo, parks, history, and more of San Diego. Curious tidbits of information are provided, for example, describing how the city and region forms the stage of the then famous Helen Hunt Jackson novel *Ramona*, which would later lend its name to an East County town.
