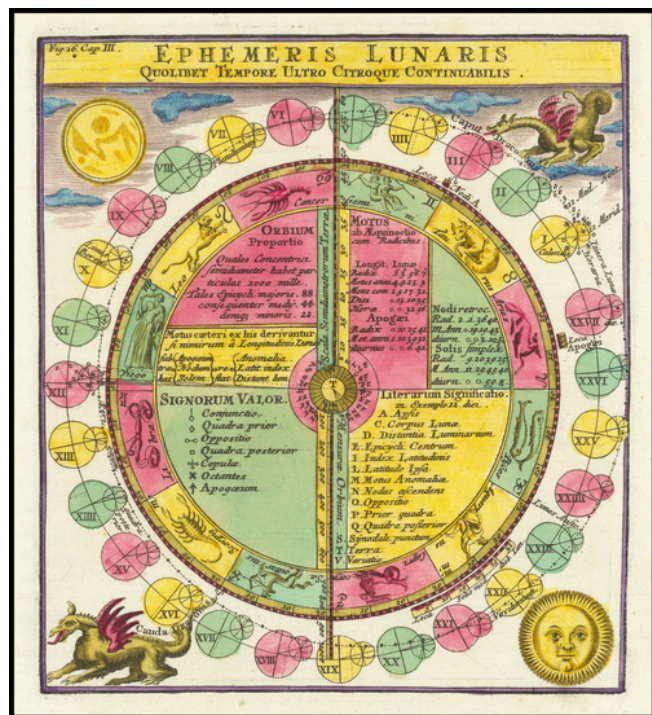




Ephemeris Lunaris Quolibet Tempore Ultro Citroque Continuabilis

Description:

Original early-18th century engraving, which served to display the phases of the moon and related lunar phenomenon. The work centers on a series of text blocks that describe various features of the moon. This is surrounded by the signs of the Zodiac, which itself is surrounded by a depiction of the moon in each of its 28 phases. The corners of the work have depictions of the sun and dragons.

This work originally appeared in the celestial atlas *Mercurii Philosophici Firmamentum Firmianum*. The work was engraved by Jakob Hering and published by Thomas for his patron Leopold Anton von Firmian, Archbishop of Salzburg.
