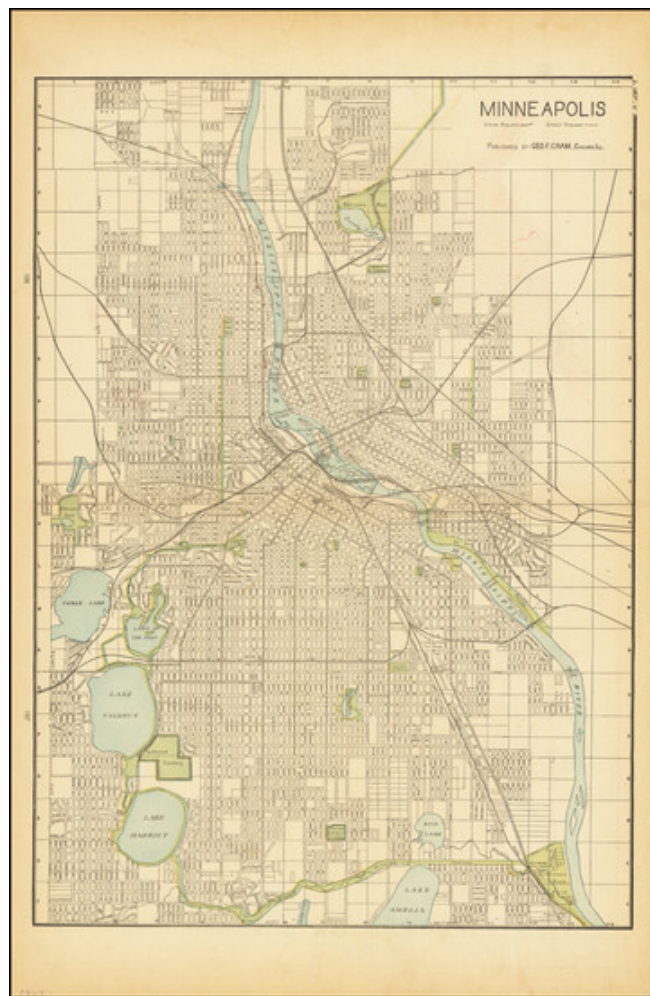

One of America's foremost business centers and a hub of Midwestern culture, Minneapolis can here be seen in a much-reduced format, barely reaching past uptown in the southwest. The exciting neighborhoods of Seward, Philips, and Como are all visible. The University of Minnesota's campus is labeled "State University."

Cram was one of the pre-eminent American Mapmakers of the late 19th Century, relying upon a cerographic printing process first applied to maps by the Morse family in the late 1830s, which ultimately
