Attractive 16th-century woodblock print of the town of Feldkirch, in westernmost Austria. The gothic-style engraving shows the city on the Rhine River, with its city walls, churches, and other buildings shown.

Feldkirch today is located at the northern Swiss-Austrian-Liechtenstein border and is now a skiing locality. This map was engraved by Munster, an early important cartographer who printed many European city views.
