Carey published his *American Atlas* in 1795, which became the first folio atlas published in America. He issued later *General Atlases* in 1796 and after. In 1814, he became the first American publisher to offer hand coloring. Highly detailed map, showing towns, rivers, roads, counties, colleges, mills, forts and other details.
