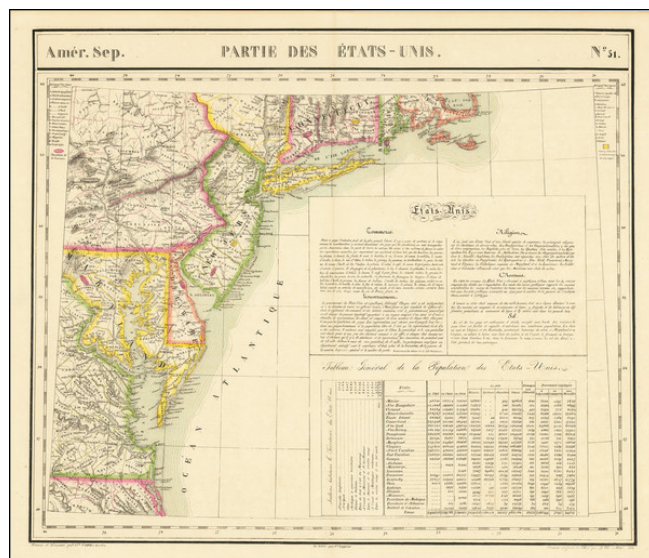

Description:

Highly detailed map of the Northeastern and Mid-Atlantic United States, extending from Cape Cod, Connecticut, and Southern New York to the Chesapeake. This map is from Vandermaelen's *Atlas Universel*, the first atlas to systematically map the world at a uniform scale.

This is a remarkable map of the eastern US, with extensive notes on the commerce, religion, government, revenues, and weather of the nation. It also includes a large state by state population table, showing growth by decade for 1790, 1800, 1810. For 1820 additional detail is noted, including populations for whites, slaves, and free blacks, as well as populations of non-citizens. Information on the employment of the nation's citizens is broken down by agriculture, commerce, and manufacturing.

The map is a testament to the phenomenal effort Vandermaelen undertook to compile contemporary and highly detailed information from all parts of the world.
