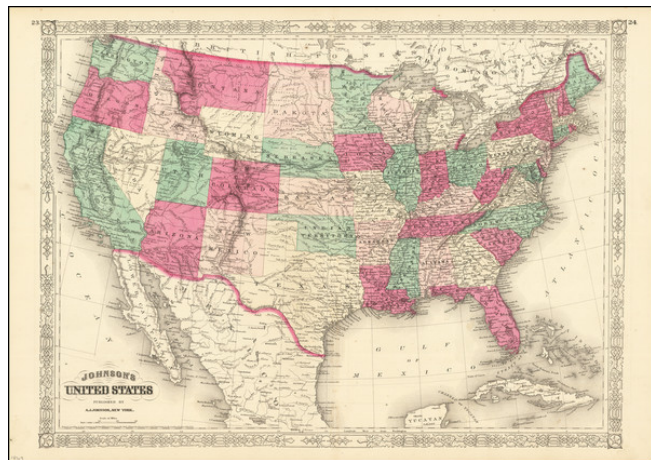

Description:

Interesting map of the United States after the end of the Civil War, published by A.J. Johnson in New York in 1869.

Wyoming appears for the first time in the 1865 edition. The lower part of Nevada is no longer truncated. Pony Express routes are shown. Oklahoma is Indian Territory.

A number of early exploration routes are shown, including the routes taken by March, Fremont, Santa Fe Route, Southern Pacific Route, Central Pacific Route, Overland Stage Route, etc. Many early towns located in the West, along with Stage Coach Stations, fort, Indian Villages and a host of other details.
