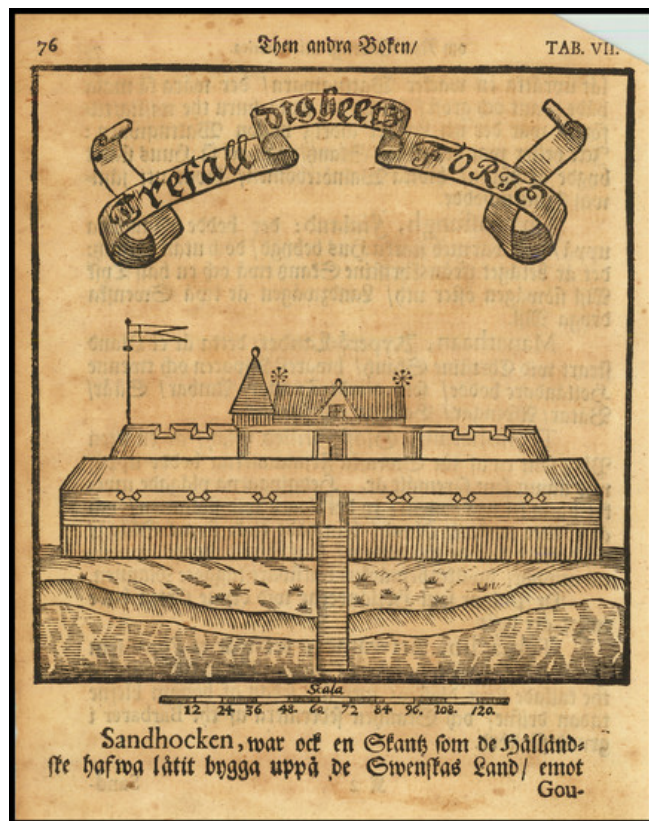

***Fort Kasimir (New Castle, Delwarare) on the Delaware River -- Later Taken By the Swedes and Renamed Trefaldigheet (Trinity Fort)***

Scarce early image of Fort Kasimir, which was originally constructed by the Dutch, but later taken by the Swedes, improved and re-fortified and re-named Trefaldigheet.

The fort was located at the present location of New Castle, Delaware, which was then called Sandhocken. The image appeared in *Kort Beskrifning om Provincien Nya Swerige uti America. . .*, published by Holm in 1702.
