Fine early distance map of California and Nevada, showing the layout of railroads, electric lines, and mail routes.

The map shows county divisions, cities, railroads, and more. The focus on railroads is fascinating - it shows how these connected the state, avoiding the major mountains of the area. Mail routes connect some of the more remote settlements, such as Bodie or "Monolake." All railroads are named. The population for all cities are listed to the left of the map, with San Diego having 75,000 inhabitants.

Two inset maps show greater focus on the Bay Area and Southern California. This map was published by Rand McNally in 1924.
