Description:

Highly detailed map of Central America, along with Chiapas and part of Oaxaca and Yucatan in Mexico.

Nice detail in the Bay of Honduras. Includes the early English provincial names of Soconusco, Suchitepec, Verapaz, Sonsonate, S. Salvador, Stl Miguel, Xeres and Ticguesgalpa, along with Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica and Panama. Exceptional detail. Pinkerton's now rare elephant folio atlas is one of the best engraved works of the period. While lesser known than the more common atlases by Cary & Thomson, it is a superior work, especially in the detail of the maps.

Detailed Condition:

A nice example, with only minor soiling at the outer margins and along the centerfold.
