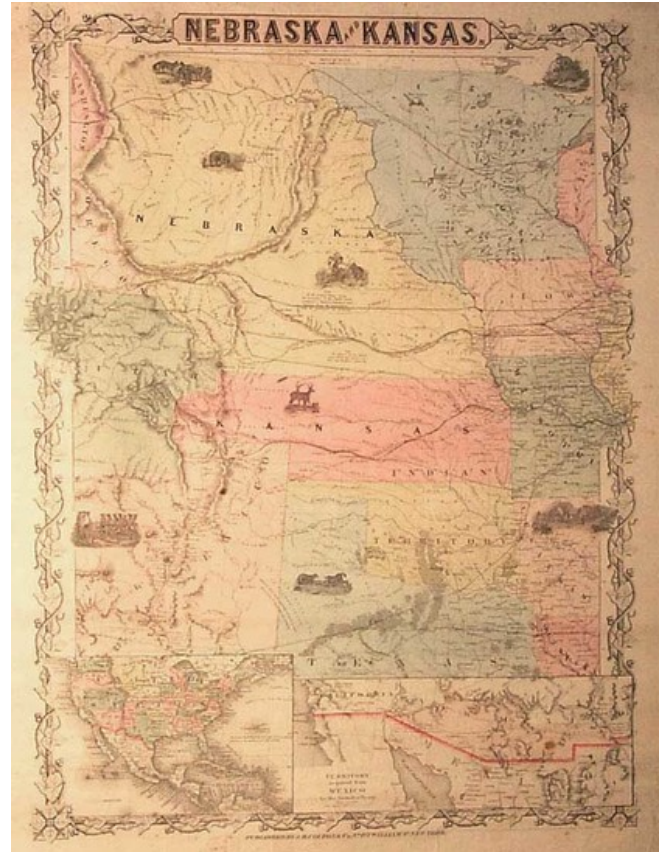

A rare find, this is a large scale map which is known to have been previously issued as a pocket map. It encompasses the territories of Nebraska and Kansas as well as a great deal more of the surrounding areas. It extends westward to the Great Salt Lake and to Crockett, Texas in the south with the range extended further south to El Paso in a vignette of the "Territory acquired from Mexico by the Gadsden Treaty" signed the previous year. The map also includes an inset of North America, and is quite detailed. Details the Sante Fe and Oregon "Routes" as well as listing both Indian and modern names for rivers and such. Also has several decorative scenes of wildlife, Indian dances and buffalo hunting and a wagon train. Streeter 3062, Rumsey 3873.
