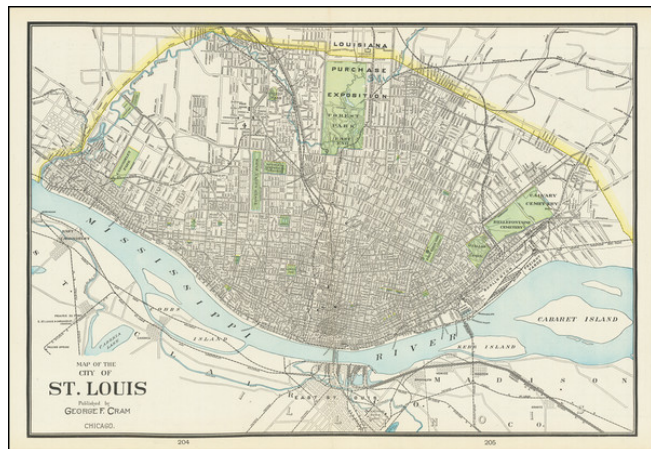

Detailed city plan of St Louis, showing streets, buildings, train lines, public places, rivers etc, oriented west.

Forest Park is pictured as the location of the 1904 World's Fair, or Louisiana Purchase Exposition, before the St. Louis Zoo was established there.

Cram was one of the pre-eminent American Mapmakers of the late 19th Century, relying upon a cerographic printing process first applied to maps by the Morse family in the late 1830s, which ultimately led to the demise of the hand-colored map.
