Shows towns, railroads, villages, post offices, forts, swamps, etc. Inset of the Keys. Only 5 counties shown in the southern part of Florida, including Dade, Monroe, Brevard, Manatee and Hillsboro. Early appearance of Miami.

Indian hunting grounds noted in between Ft. Poinsett and Key Biscayne Bay. Many early forts appear. The GLO surveys are not yet complete in the Everglades and elsewhere.
