

Advertising pictorial map of Nashville, Tennessee, focusing on the city's music industry. Naming a number of places of interest throughout the map, such as Andrew Jackson's Hermitage, Vanderbilt University, and the Parthenon, this lively pictorial map captures the city as it was in 1972.

Attractively drawn and with the Cumberland River flowing through the center of town, this map captures Nashville as a hub of opportunity embedded in countryside and greenspace. Advertisements line the sides of the map and the verso shows the highlights of the city's musicians. One panel suggests to the viewer that the greatest artists in Music City are: Lynn Anderson, Johnny Cash, Tommy Cash, David Houston, Jody Miller, and Kris Kristofferson, among others.
