Description:

One of the most decorative maps of East Frisia and its important shipping center of Emden and the Watten Islands, from the cartography of Ubbo Emmius, a local cartographer and historian (1547-1625).

The map appeared in Petrus Kaerius's (Peter Van der Keere) *Germaniae Inferior id est, XVII Provinciarum ejus novae et exactae Tabulae Geographicae*, first published in Amsterdam in 1617.

Van der Keere's atlas was the first separately published atlas of the Low Countries.

The map includes a view of Emden, a coat of arms and costumes showing typical regional dress.
