John Arrowsmith's 1861 map of part of British Columbia, including the Colony of Vancouver Island, the Colony of British Columbia, and some land east of the Rocky Mountains. The fur-trading district of New Caledonia is noted as is a report of gold near Barrier (present-day Barriere), one of the sites of a gold rush in that era.

The map was published for the *Journal of the Royal Geographical Society* by J. Murray. It was used to illustrate the papers of "Mr. Justice Begbie, Comr. Mayne, R.N. Lt. Palmer, R.E. & Mr. Downie."
