***HMS Victory - But Not Nelson's.***

Intricately engraved portrait of His Majesty's Ship *Royal George*, a Royal Navy 100-gun ship of the line launched in 1675, which was originally called *Royal James*.

Following the Glorious Revolution, the ship was renamed *Victory*, then *Royal George* in 1714, at the time of King George's accession to the throne but changed back to *Victory* the following year.

The vessel burned to the waterline in 1721, with the name *Victory* eventually passing to Nelson's flagship at Trafalgar, which is still in the Royal Navy to this day.
