

Rare William Faden Plan of the Parish of St. Martin in the Fields, London

Fine 18th-century map of the area around Westminster in London, stretching from Hyde Park Corner to Covent Garden.

The plan shows Green Park, Buckingham Palace, Charing Cross, Leicester Square, and Scotland Yard.

This plan was originally commissioned by the Westminster Paving Commissioners to aid in the development of St. Martin in the Fields, including its paving and lighting. The Paving Commissioners had first been formed in 1762.

Detailed Condition:

Small area of loss in upper margin. Fold split at base of centerfold.
