An Important Postal Plan of Greater London

Fine large map of London, prepared to illustrate the limits of the Two-penny postal delivery service around London.

The map reaches to the Serpentine in Hyde Park, Stoke Newington, Blackwall and Camberwell. The red circle marks the extent of the Two-Penney Post deliveries.

The map was regularly updated by Cary and can be considered on of the best means for tracking the growth of London in the 1820s to 1840s. Howgego notes 19 states of the map, this being one of the earliest.
