A late state of Nicolas Sanson's engraved map of Bavaria, first published in Paris in 1655 and here from a 1703 reissue. The map shows the region of Bavaria south of the Danube, all the way to the foothills of the Alps near the Swiss border.

The map shows a number of rivers, lakes, mountains, forests, and more. Cities shown include Munich, Ingolstadt, Straubing, Ulm, and going so far north as Nuremberg.

Nicolas Sanson was one of the most important French cartographers of the 17th century, and particularly renowned for his highly accurate and aesthetically simple maps.
