## **Description:**

Fascinating original antique map of France, showing the region as it stood during the pre-Revolutionary period, dating back to the Roman Empire.

The map shows layers of nomenclature, from the Roman names of various cities and regions to the "Provinces" of the *Ancien Regime* that persisted until the Revolution. The regions conquered by Clovis are shown.

This map was published by Augustin Legrand and issued in his *Atlas Elementaire*.

## **Detailed Condition:**
