This map shows part of the Baltic and Gulf of Riga, including the modern countries of Poland, Lithuania, Ukraine, and Latvia. Germania was defined by Rome as having two regions: Lesser Germania, west and south of the Rhine, occupied by the Romans, and Greater Germania (Magna Germania) east of the Rhine.
