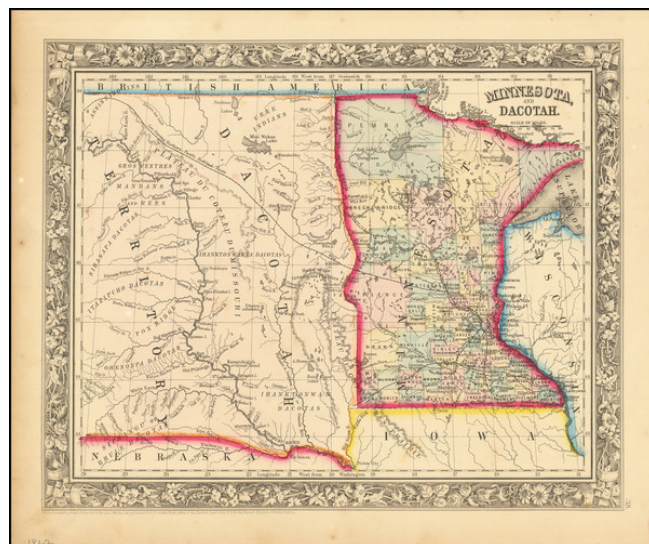

### Description:

First state of this finely detailed map of Minnesota and Dakota Territory, published by Samuel Augustus Mitchell Jr.

Dacotah Territory extends well west of the Missouri River. Indian lands predominate the Dacotah Territory, with no less than 5 different bands of Dakota Indians present, as well as others including Cree, Assiniboine, Ree, and Mandan.

Nice detail along the Missouri River and its Tributaries. Several early forts are noted including Ft. Pierre, Ft. Lookout, Ft. Clarke, and Ft. Berthold.

A number of counties are still not formed in Minnesota. Lake Bemidji is labeled as "Pemidji Lake" and the city of Bemidji is absent and would not be surveyed by European Americans until 1874. Stevens route is shown for the Northern Pacific, along with existing and other proposed rail lines.

### Detailed Condition:

Original hand-color by county. Faint toning and foxing, largely confined to the margins.
