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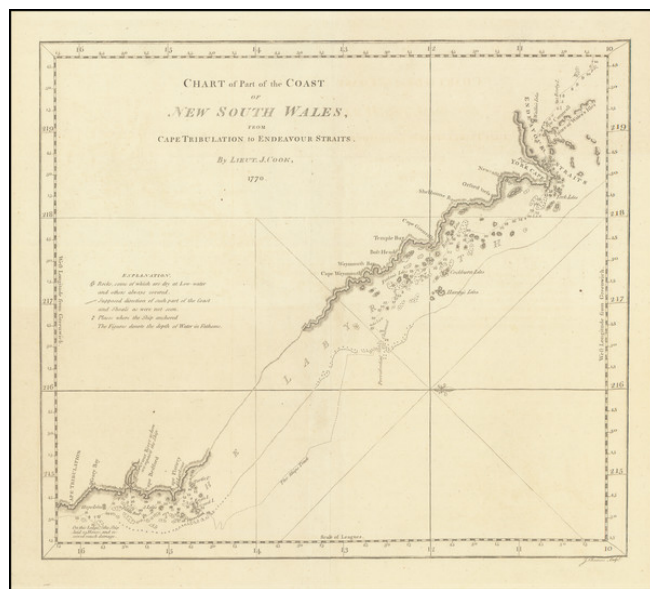

Nice example of Captain James Cook's map of a portion of the east coast of Australia, from the Official Account of the Cook's First Voyage.

Oriented with west at the top, Cook's map is the first printed map to concentrate on a section of Australia's east coast, covering the Queensland coast from Cape Tribulation to the Endeavour Straits. The chart meticulously tracks Cook's course along the East Coast, including the details of the Labryinth, where Cook's chart hit a reef on the Great Barrier Reef
